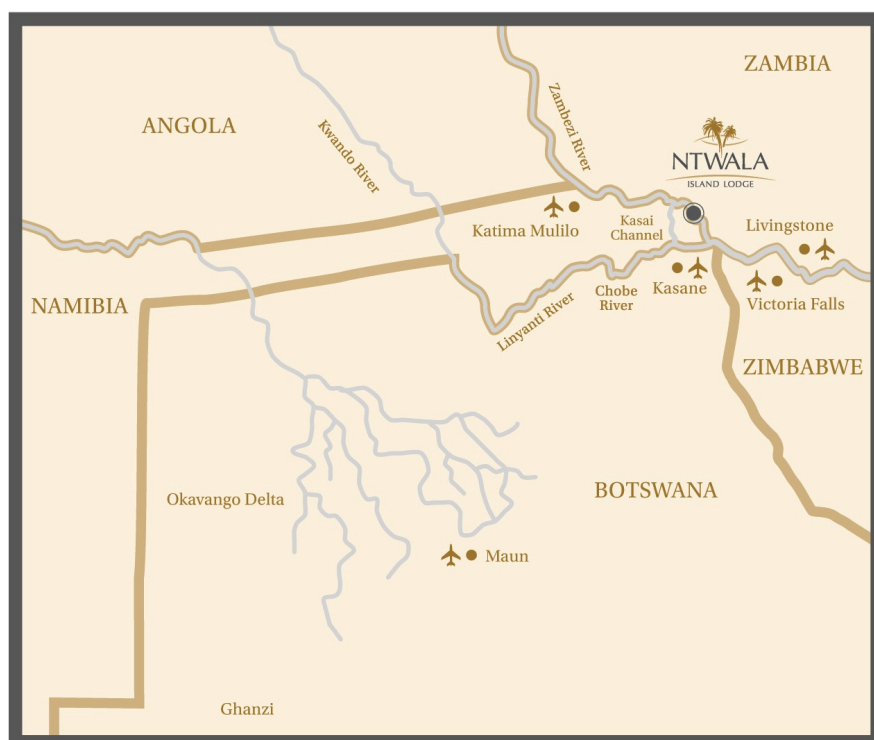


Ntwala Island Lodge Directions & Access



Ntwala Island Lodge is in the Eastern Caprivi of Namibia; close to the junction of four countries - Namibia, Botswana, Zambia and Zimbabwe - and near the meeting place of the mighty Zambezi and Chobe Rivers.

Access By Air

- A direct charter onto Impalila Island is available. However, private charters must obtain authority to land and take off in Namibian territory (either Mpacha or Impalila depending on destination) from the DCA in Windhoek - Tel +264(61) 23 4100 Fax: +264(61)23 6649.
- There are daily commercial flights to Victoria Falls or Livingstone with British Airways or SAA. From these airports and depending on arrangements made with IIA Reservations, one may charter direct to Impalila Island or take a road transfer to Kasane Immigration jetty. At the jetty an IIA guide will collect you for a scenic boat transfer to the lodge. En route Namibian Immigration will be cleared.
- Commercial flights to Kasane with Air Botswana are available every Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Clients will be transferred from the airport to Kasane Immigration and then by boat to Impalila Island Lodge. Namibian Immigration will be cleared on Impalila Island .

Access By Road

- Guests can drive from Johannesburg through Botswana to Kasane on a tarred road for collection by boat from Kasane Immigration (Chobe river), where an Ntwala guide will meet you.
- Once cleared through Kasane Immigration, you will drive your vehicle to Chobe Safari Lodge for safe parking. Our guide will meet you at the reception and take you to the jetty for your boat transfer to the lodge.
- Visitors driving through Botswana must also provide proof of third party insurance from within the Southern African Customs Union or third party insurance can be purchased at the Botswana border control. All foreign vehicles are subject to a road safety levy upon entry.
- Namibian road tax needs to be paid when entering Namibia.
